	<p>Can providers be a resource? (Input --&gt; goal)</p> <p>-Funding may be more limited next year</p>	
	<p>"Catch things early"; before it becomes a crisis: mental wellness</p> <p>What do we need to do from a provider level to start earlier intervention?</p>	
	<p>We want people to be able to ask for the help that they need but we also need to have enough providers.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- What are the available options with a person's given circumstances?</li> </ul>	<p><i>Bob</i></p>
	<p>How do we get this awareness in our community?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- How do we get the word out?</li> </ul> <p>How much (as a provider network) are we doing out there? What needs to be accomplished to make people aware?</p> <p>Think outside of the box; what do we need to do to make it happen?</p> <p>Community Integration – networking – awareness of having consumer participating in a group where they are bringing knowledge; "get rid of the stigma"</p> <p>People want information: "We aren't getting it out enough"</p> <p>Providers are coming together – important to make it aware to the general public</p>	<p>Get the following information for the next meeting: (Lindsey will gather information)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- County statistics</li> <li>- SAMHSA</li> <li>- Evidenced-based practices and guidelines (National Council)</li> <li>- Technology app</li> <li>- Crisis</li> <li>- Integration of information</li> <li>- Sharing resources</li> <li>- Wellness recovery</li> </ul> <p><i>Diane</i> will bring</p>

	<p>Let's get people help/support before a person is in danger or crisis</p> <p>Things that are necessary for mental health:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Food</li> <li>- Shelter</li> <li>- Employment</li> <li>- Connections</li> </ul> <p>Utilize technology to serve people where they are (transportation issues)</p> <p>Utilize transportation resources</p>	
	<p>WRAP Plans</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- There is a need for clinicians to attend training</li> <li>- These plans are very effective; curriculum is already developed; not difficult to learn</li> </ul> <p>Problem – No funding</p>	
	<p>Awareness seems to be on an "as needed basis"</p> <p>Could there be a central area? People do not know about resources</p> <p>2-1-1: More people need to know about it (24/7?). People may be more likely to call rather than crisis</p> <p>Having a resource available for people to talk (a warm line) – effective in other counties</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A warm line could provide choices</li> </ul>
